WHAT ARE THE ACTIVITIES AND EXPERIENCE OF THE ORGANISATION IN THE AREAS RELEVANT FOR THIS APPLICATION?

Senza Confini APS is a youth-driven association where young people take center stage in designing and implementing impactful initiatives. Our work spans multiple levels, leveraging the diverse skills, knowledge, and passions of our members. Through collaboration with local stakeholders and youth networks, we create opportunities for young people to grow as active citizens and develop valuable expertise in project management and community engagement. Our commitment is to involve young people from our area in every activity, fostering a thriving network of youth workers who gain hands-on experience while working alongside us. Our efforts can be grouped into three main areas:

1. Local Networking and Information Initiatives

At Senza Confini, we actively promote awareness and provide vital information to the citizens of La Spezia and the surrounding areas.

- **Community Outreach:** We organize campaigns on pressing issues, such as combating violence against women, raising awareness about public health measures (e.g., anti-COVID hygiene protocols), and more. These campaigns are tailored to reach vulnerable groups, including the elderly, immigrants, and NEETs.
- **Collaborative Networking:** By involving other local organizations, we build a strong network for exchanging best practices, ensuring a meaningful and sustainable impact.
- **Digital Outreach:** Through our social media platforms, we extend our reach, sharing knowledge and resources with the community and beyond.

2. Event Creation and Sociocultural Projects

We design and implement events and small-scale sociocultural initiatives to address diverse community needs.

- **Cultural and Educational Programs:** From promoting art, theater, and environmental awareness in schools to fostering an appreciation for local culture, we aim to enrich the lives of young people and the broader community.
- **Community Dialogues:** We facilitate meetings between local government representatives and civil society actors to address community issues and strengthen civic engagement.
- **Fundraising and Support Initiatives:** By pooling the skills and resources of our members, we organize fundraisers to support individuals or organizations in need, often securing funding through creative methods such as dinners, bank foundation grants, or municipal contributions.
